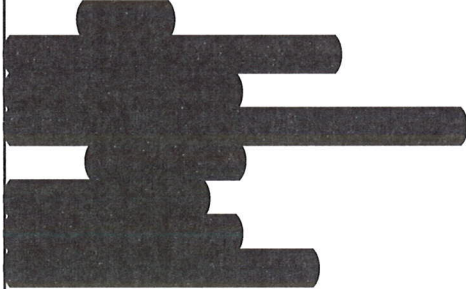

On 20-MAR-2017 at approximately 1450 hrs the Brookfield Police Department responded to a suspicious incident where the following subjects stopped at a residence and spoke with the home owner (elderly subject) and asked if he would like to for them to do tuckpointing around his chimney. The subjects told the homeowner that they could do it for \$50.00USC, but half way through the work they advised the homeowner that the project was going to be 1500.00 usc if they were going to do whole chimney, for the mortar that they were using was \$50.00 a pound. Once officers arrived on scene the subjects just requested to leave without pay. They were issued a citation for not obtaining a permit and left the area.
