

VILLAGE OF LYONS
BOND ISSUE NOTIFICATION ACT NOTICE

The Village of Lyons will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, May 5, 2020 at 6:45 p.m. in its Board Room at 4200 Lawndale Avenue, Lyons, IL 60534. The purpose of the hearing will be to receive comments on the proposal to sell the following bonds:

\$25,800,000 Taxable General Obligation Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source), Series 2020 for paying moneys to the Village of Lyons Police Pension Fund (the “Police Pension Fund”) and the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund (the “IMRF”) (collectively, the “Pension Payments”) to be used for the payment of the unfunded liability of the Police Pension Fund and IMRF.

At the public hearing, the Village will explain the reasons for the proposed bond issue and permit persons desiring to be heard an opportunity to present written or oral testimony within reasonable time limits. The hearing may be adjourned to another date without further notice other than a motion to be entered upon the minutes fixing the time, place, and date of the reconvened meeting.

Attendance at the public hearing will be limited to the public but will be conducted in compliance with the Governor’s Executive Orders 2020-7, 2020-10, and 2020-18. Persons testifying may be limited in their ability to present oral testimony at the public hearing.
